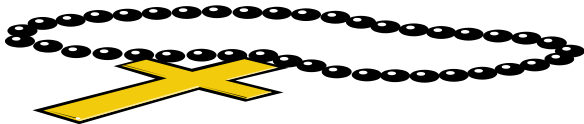

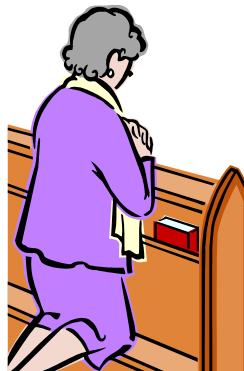

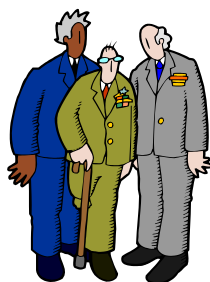

- 1) Attend Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation and rest from servile work.
- 2) Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation at least once a year.
- 3) Receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist at least during the Easter Season.
- 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5) Help provide for the material needs of the Church. (Living Stewardship way of live including tithing to your own ability.)
