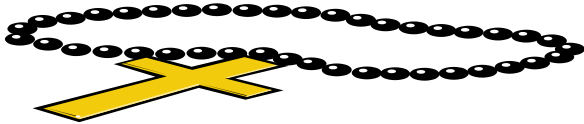

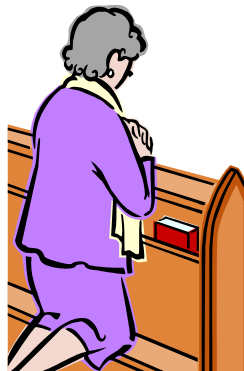

Stations of the Cross Schedule

Wednesdays:

Beginning February 22 and every Wednesday at 2:45pm we will have children's Way of the Cross.

Stations at St. Mary's will be every Friday at 7:30pm, with Mass following at 8:00pm.

LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting. This obligation applies from age 18 to 59. Fasting is understood as taking only one full meal and two lesser meals.

Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are obligatory days of complete abstinence (of meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.

People who are unable to practice bodily penance, perhaps due to pregnancy, illness, or hard physical labors may choose another form of penance or charity. The Church urges that works of penance be linked to works of charity – for example, use the money saved on less expensive meals or no snakes – to feed the poor.

- 4) Observe the days of fasting and abstinence established by the Church.
- 5) Help provide for the material needs of the Church. (Living Stewardship way of live including tithing to your own ability.)

Can you keep a secret?

Remember the last time someone “blabbed” your secrets? Perhaps you were the one to let a story slip out by accident. How hard it is to keep news to ourselves. We tell one trusted friend, who shares with just one person and so on till the story is common knowledge. It seems nothing can be kept secret, at least not for very long. Good or bad, happy or sad...we just can't wait to tell!

So why is God so easy to keep quiet about?

Too often we are strangely silent about the comfort our faith brings. We keep lips sealed when an opportunity to share the “Good News” appears, afraid of offending.

Comanded to share our faith, we instead treat it like a shameful secret. What a contrast to the leper in today's gospel. Healed miraculously, he was under strict instructions to “tell no one” yet he immediately spread the news far and wide. His infectious disease was replaced by an equally compelling contagion, enthusiasm for the work of God. It's a disease we could all stand to catch.

The leper had a story worth telling the world. Don't you?
