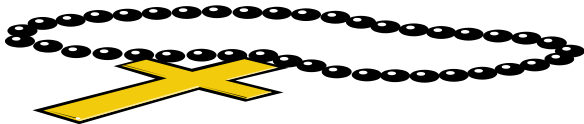

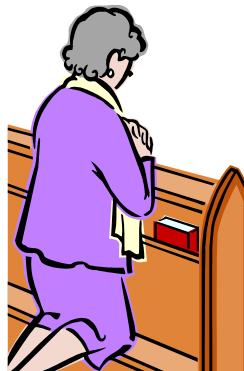

**LENTEN FAST AND ABSTINENCE**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **fasting**. This obligation applies from age 18 to 59. Fasting is understood as taking only one full meal and two lesser meals.

Ash Wednesday, the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday are obligatory days of complete abstinence (of meat) for all who have completed their 14<sup>th</sup> year.

People who are unable to practice bodily penance, perhaps due to pregnancy, illness, or hard physical labors may choose another form of penance or charity. The Church urges that works of penance be linked to works of charity – for example, use the money saved on less expensive meals or no snakes – to feed the poor.

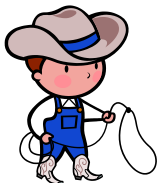

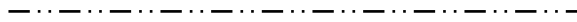

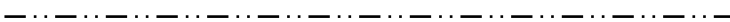

*No room!*

We've all heard the story, the paralytic man lowered through the roof to Jesus. Thoughtfully we discuss forgiveness, healing and false pride. But what about a more basic question.... why wouldn't anyone make room? Imagine that over-packed room. People scoffing and gawking. Some waiting to be healed, some already healed. And not one of them was willing to move, to make room for those desperate to get in. Miracles were first come-first serve, leaving those at the back of the line to fend for themselves.

The image still applies today. In our easy religious freedom, we forget those who worship in secret, risking lives to attend a simple service. Alone they courageously persist, unwilling to accept any obstacle as insurmountable. It is these stranded souls who climb the roof today, while we comfortably recline on the floor at Jesus feet. Where are our hands reaching out to draw these wounded ones closer to Him? Where are our shoulders lifting up those who can no longer walk? It is time for us to make room at the cross for all the children of the earth, ensuring that each heart can reach Him in their hour of need.
